## *Eligibility*

Candidates who have passed their Bachelor Examination in Science, Arts with minimum 50% (Aggregate) and Commerce, BCA, BBA, BBM, having 55% (Aggregate) from any UGC recognized university of India or an equivalent degree.

## *How to Apply*

There is a system of joint Entrance at the State Level. Successful applicants of CET are admitted after their counseling.

Enclosure with the Application:-

- a. Self Attested copy of matriculation or S.S Examination certificate.
- b. Self Attested copy of all mark sheets up to 10th to Bachelor or Post graduate degree.
- c. C.L.C/D.L.C any Migration
- d. Self Attested copy of other activities, accomplishment, if any.
- e. Those students, coming from another university, they must be submitting their migration certificates.
- f. Self Attested copy of Identity Proof.

**Required documents at the time of Admission:-**

- a. Original C.L.C/D.L.C and other original certificates and degree are to be produced at the time of admission for verification/Submission.
- b. Admission charges as prescribed in the prospectus.
- c. Two sets of all the documents duly self attested
- d. Original mark sheets of matriculation till the last qualification.
- e. Original caste certificate.
- f. Original C.L.C/D.L.C
- g. Original migration certificate of those candidates who received the degree from other than T.M.B.U., Bhagalpur.

### *Other Information*

- Admission of any candidate is provisional and may be cancelled if any discrepancy is detected in the paper/document submitted or the candidate fails to comply with the rules regulations and other conditions laid down by the college in the bye-laws as well as prospectus of the college.
- Admission even after confirmation may be cancelled in case the students not showing satisfactory progress in their studies as well as on the ground of conduct in and out of the college.
- In case a candidate fails to report on the due day with the required documents and fee for admission, he will be responsible failing in his/her claim for admission and seat falling vacant will be allotted to other candidate in the waiting list.
- Special facilities for poor and deserving trainees will be made available to the extent possible.
- Rules of eligibility are followed strictly; the college however reserves the right to refuse admission to the candidate without mentions any reason.
- All students admitted to the college shall have to sign a form containing the code of conduct which will be furnished to them by the office; any violation of law/laws will justify their expulsion from the college.

### *Library Rules*

1. The books may be retained by the trainee-teachers up to a period of 7 days after which the books must be returned or got re-issued, In case of default, special fine shall be imposed.
2. At the time of returning the book if the same is found defaced or damaged in any way, the borrower will be required to pay its price and damages.
3. Leave from the college does not imply exemption from the return of library books. The books may be returned to the library by post under registered cover, if necessary.
4. Trainee-Teacher is expected to observe perfect silence in the Library and is expected not to disturb others in any way.

5. Nontransferable Library-cum-Identity cards are issued to all the trainee-teachers and books will be issued only on these cards. Trainee-teachers must get the identity cards within a month after paying their fees, Passport size photographs should be handed over to the librarian. Loss of the card should be immediately reported to the Librarian who will issue duplicate card on the payment of Rs. 25/- only.
6. Only one book can be procured and issued at a time.
7. The responsibility of Trainee-teacher will be over until the book(s) is shown as returned on the library card. They are advised to be very careful in getting the signatures of the librarian on their cards while returning the books.
8. Books borrowed from the library members and reference books, text books, current periodicals will not be issued except for consultation within the library.

### *Internal Examination*

1. Compulsory house tests in addition to the monthly tests will be held during the whole year.
2. If a student is absent himself/herself from any of the terminal examination held by the college, his/her assessment will not be sent to the University. However, the candidate will be considered for re-admission if he qualifies the papers and also special fine will be imposed for his absence. The internal assessment will be assessed according to the performance in the curricular as well as co-curricular activities.
3. Students must extend cooperation to the Supervisory Staff Any student found guilty of using unfair means during the examination shall be punished according to the seriousness of the offence.
4. Although progress report embodying the results of the house tests is forwarded to the parents/guardians by the college, it is the responsibility of every student to bring his/her result to the notice of his/her parents guardians.
